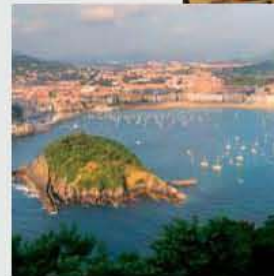

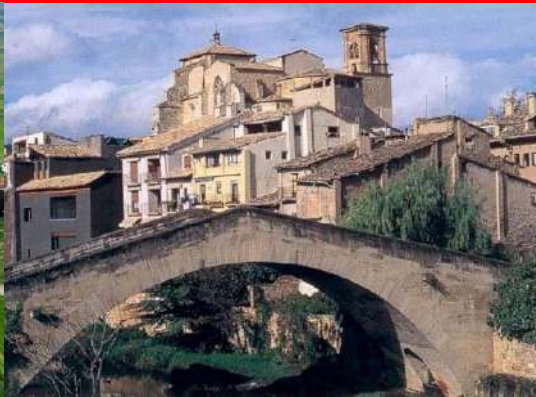

D1 Thursday CITY OF ORIGIN – PAMPLONA

Reception in Pamplona and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. In the afternoon, walk through the historical center of Pamplona. Dinner at a Gastronomic Society and explanation of the program.

D2 Friday PAMPLONA: Suso and Yuso monasteries, Najera and Laguardia.

Breakfast and departure to meet the Pamplona Kingdom history along the Autonomous Basque Community, La Rioja and Navarra. Our route, surrounded by vineyards, follows the Pilgrim's way to Santiago.

First we will enter to La Rioja, visiting the Suso and Yuso monasteries; there, we will see the first writings in Spanish and Basque. After that, in Najera we will visit the pantheon of the kings of Pamplona inside the Santa María la Real Monastery. Lunch.

We will continue to Laguardia at the Autonomous Basque Community. There is located an ancient defensive castle, built in the 10th century. Return to Pamplona and accommodation.

D3 Saturday PAMPLONA: Urbasa-Andia Natural Park and Pilgrim's way to Santiago

Breakfast and departure to the Pamplona Basin to do a short stop in Etxauri and Salinas de Oro geographically located on the Natural Park of Urbasa and Andia. Visit to the salt mines; after that, to Estella, where we will have lunch.

Although in its term some archaeological remains have been found that retract us to the Bronze Age, Estella-Lizarra dates its birth in the year 1090, when the king Sancho Ramirez granted its Fuero or jurisdiction. Norms in which it tried to privilege the settlement of settlers with a French origin that allowed the economic diversification of the kingdom and take advantage of the importance that the pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela was reaching at the moment.

D4 Sunday PAMPLONA: Olite, Cerco of Artajona, Roman Villa of Andelos.

Breakfast and departure at midday to visit the first place: Olite and its Palace. The royal palace of Olite is an evidence of the courtier splendor lived during the Navarrese medieval times.

We will continue our visit at the Cerco of Artajona where one of the most important fortifications stands on the highest section.

We will arrive to the Roman city of Andelos at Mendigorria, where there was a human settlement dating back to the fourth and third centuries BC. It is possible that, since the 2nd century BC they have already established the first contacts between the Basques and the Roman world. The 1st and 2nd centuries are the most splendid of the city.

D1 Sunday PLACE OF ORIGIN – PAMPLONA

Reception in Pamplona and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. In the afternoon, walk through the historical center of Pamplona. Dinner at a Gastronomic Society and explanation of the program.

D2 Monday PAMPLONA – ISABA:

Breakfast and departure to Isaba, a Pyrenean village in the Roncal Valley. We will also know Orbaizeta and the Irati Forest, the largest beech forest after the Black Forest.

We follow up the road to Abaurrea Alta to discover the “Jardin de las Estelas” (Garden of the memorial stones), Medieval stones which evokes part of the Basque people history. We will continue our journey parallel to the Pyrenees, and after a brief stop in Ochagavía, we will arrive at Isaba. Lunch.

In the afternoon, we will know the Roncal Valley and its natural corners. Return to Isaba and free time to enjoy this typical mountain village. Accommodation.

D3 Tuesday ISABA – BAIONA: Kakueta Gorges. Maule. St. Jean Pied Port

Breakfast and after visiting the Arrako Dolmen (if time allows it), we will cross the Pyrenees, passing by the ski slopes of La Pierre de Saint Martin or Arette, to descend by its north slope to the Gorges de Kakueta, in Santa Grazi. We will walk through the catwalks at the foot of walls of more than 350 meters in height, in a wonderful natural environment.

Lunch and brief stop in Maule, capital of Xuberoa. Continuation to St Jean de Pied de Port (Donibane Garazi), capital of Lower Navarre. Arrival in Baiona, visit and lodging.

D4 Wednesday BAIONE: La Rhune, Basque Cake Museum, St Jean Pied Port

Breakfast and departure to take the rack railway train to La Rhune. We will follow up enjoying the Basque Cake Museum.

We will taste this famous basque dessert and we will get to know its elaboration secrets as well as its origin story. Later we will approach the Basque Coast to know its warrior past (The St Jean de Luz Corsaries) and its touristic present. After visiting Biarritz return to the hotel in Baiona and accommodation.

D5 Thursday BAIONE – HONDARRIBIA PAMPLONA // SAN SEBASTIAN

Breakfast and visit to Hondarribia, where we will get to know its important cultural and artistic heritage. Hondarribia's walls – most of them still remain on and in constant recovery process that gives it a special physiognomy.

They evoke an epic past and impregnating every corner, alley, and place of aromas, flavors and sounds that transport us to other eras. Then transfer to San Sebastian or Pamplona.

Breakfast and departure to visit the Basque Coast. First, we will visit Biarritz, known by its famous beaches, its therapeutic waters and the surfer scene. We approach to Baiona where Nive/Errobi and Adur/Aturri rivers join. In Saint-Jean-de-Luz, where we will see buildings that date from the 17th century, when Saint-Jean-de-Luz was one of the most important fishing port of France. Back to the hotel in San Sebastian and free time.

D4 Wednesday SAN SEBASTIAN – PAMPLONA: Ordizia Market, Aralar Natural Park.

Breakfast and visit to the Ordizia market, international reference of gastronomy for its famous blood sausages. We will continue across the magical Aralar Natural Park discovering its rivers, springs, rich vegetation, fauna and myths and legends. Lunch and departure to Pamplona. Accommodation in the hotel and rest. Walk through the old town of Pamplona in the afternoon. Dinner in a Gastronomic Society.

D5 Thursday PAMPLONA: Natural Park of Bardenas Reales, Tudela, Artajona

Breakfast and departure to Nuestra Señora del Yugo, from where we will have an impressive panorama of this spectacular Natural Park Biosphere Reserve. We follow up our trip along the Navarre Ribera until arrive to Tudela, second city in extent and importance of Navarra's territory. In Tudela, Muslim, Jewish and Mozarabic lived during more than 400 years. Visit and lunch. After having lunch, and on the way to Pamplona, we will visit the Cerco de Artajona and its huge walled complex. Return to Pamplona and free time.

D6 Friday PAMPLONA: Leyre Monastery, Ujue, Javier and Olite castles.

Breakfast and departure from Pamplona to visit the Leyre Monastery, an iconic place due to the important role he has played in the history of the Kingdom of Navarre. We will continue our journey to visit the Javier Castle, birthplace of San Francisco de Javier, patron saint of Navarre. We will continue our journey until we reach the medieval village of Ujue / Uxue where we will have lunch. After visiting the Fortress church we will continue to Olite, to visit its impressive and beautiful Castle. Return to Pamplona and free time.

D7 Saturday PAMPLONA: Baztán Valley and Zugarramurdi

Breakfast and departure to Elizondo. Visit to the main city of the Baztan Valley. We will enjoy its many stately houses and palaces. Its most emblematic building is the baroque palace of Arizkunenea.

Lunch at Zugarramurdi. Free time to visit the caves and the Witch Museum (Herbalists, midwives and women in general) who were accused by the Catholic Church of being witches. Return to Pamplona and free time.

D1 Sunday CITY OF ORIGIN – PAMPLONA

Reception in Pamplona and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. In the afternoon, walk through the historical center of Pamplona. Dinner at a Gastronomic Society and explanation of the program.

D2 Monday PAMPLONA – ISABA: Irati Forest, Ochagavia, Roncal Valley

Breakfast and departure to Isaba, a Pyrenean village in the Roncal Valley. On the way we will meet Orbaizeta and the Irati Forest, the largest beech forest after the Black Forest.

We will continue along Abaurrea Alta to visit the "Estelas Garden" and after a short stop in Ochagavia, we will arrive at Isaba. Lunch. In the afternoon, we will know the Roncal Valley and its natural corners. Return to Isaba and free time to enjoy this typical mountain village. Accommodation.

D3 Tuesday ISABA – BAIONA: Kakueta Gorges, Maule, St Jean Pied Port

Breakfast and after seeing the Dolmen of Arrako (if time allows it), we will cross the Pyrenees passing by the ski slopes of La Pierre de Saint Martin or Arette, to descend by its north slope to the Gorges de Kakueta, in Santa Grazi. We will walk through the catwalks at the foot of walls of more than 350 meters height, in a wonderful natural environment. Lunch and brief stop in Maule, capital of Xuberoa. Continuation to St Jean de Pied de Port (Donibane Garazi), capital of Lower Navarre. Arrival in Baiona, visit and lodging.

D4 Wednesday BAIONA: La Rhune, Basque Cake Museum, St Jean de Luz, Biarritz

Breakfast and departure for the interior to climb on the train rack to La Rhune and crown the first peak of the Pyrenees. We will continue to enjoy our senses visiting the Basque Cake Museum. Later we will approach the Basque Coast to know its warrior past (the Corsairs of St Jean de Luz) and its tourist attraction. After visiting Biarritz, return to Bayonne and accommodation.

D5 Thursday BAIONA – HONDARRIBIA – PAMPLONA

Breakfast and visit to Hondarribia, where we will know its walls, many of them standing and in constant process of recovery. Then transfer to Pamplona and overnight at the hotel. In the afternoon visit to the historic part of Pamplona. Dinner at a Gastronomic Society and explanation of the program.

D6 Friday PAMPLONA: Suso and Yuso Monasteries, Najera and Laguardia

Breakfast and departure to visit the Monasteries of Suso and Yuso, where we will see the first writings in Castilian and Basque languages. Later in Nájera we will visit the pantheon of the kings of Pamplona, in the Monastery of Santa Maria La Real. Lunch. We will continue to Laguardia, an old defensive castle built on the borders of the kingdom of Navarre in the 10th century. Return to Pamplona and lodging.

D7 Saturday PAMPLONA: Natural ParK Urbasa-Andia and Pilgrims Way

Breakfast and departure through the Pamplona Basin to make a brief stop in Etxauri and in Salinas de Oro, located in the foothills of the Natural Park of Urbasa and Andía. Lunch in Estella.

On the way to Pamplona, we will visit Puente la Reina, "crossroads", a medieval town where the two main routes of the Camino de Santiago, Santa María de Eunate. This building was built during the reign of Sancho the Wise in the second half of the 12th century, around 1170, and Obanos, which in the thirteenth century was erected as a standard in the struggle against the abuse of certain Navarrese nobles.

Breakfast and transfer to the bus station to go by regular bus to Bilbao. Assistance and transfer to the hotel. A complete Dossier will be delivered with information about the Basque

Autonomous Community and details of the program. Accommodation at the hotel in Bilbao.



D6 Tuesday BILBAO - SAN SEBASTIAN: Sanctuary of Loyola and Getaria

We will enter the valleys of the interior of Bizkaia and after bordering the important town of Durango, we will pass by Eibar, Elgoibar and Azkoitia, this last locality keeps the oldest towers of Gipuzkoa, until arriving at the Sanctuary of Loyola with the Basilica and The Tower House of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuit order.

We will continue along the coastal road with its magnificent views over the Bay of Biscay to the beautiful fishing village and the walled village of Getaria, the birthplace of Juan Sebastián Elcano. Then we will continue the route, passing through Zarauz, the most traditional enclave and tourist reference since the 19th century. Its magnificent beach, the largest of Gipuzkoa with 2500m. And its old part with its picturesque streets and cosmopolitan atmosphere.

We will continue the trip to San Sebastian, where we will take a panoramic tour to appreciate the magnificent walks and walks. Free time for lunch. After that, we will walk through the Old Part, a plot of narrow streets that preserves the old medieval layout. You will be transferred to the hotel and free time to enjoy the city on your own.

D7 Wednesday SAN SEBASTIAN

Breakfast. Day off in San Sebastian. Our guide will inform you about the activities to be carried out during that day. Accommodation at the Hotel.

D8 Thursday SAN SEBASTIAN – VITORIA: Ordizia, Oñati, Aranzazu Sanctuary and Laguardia

Breakfast and departure to Vitoria. Passing through Lasarte, Andoain and Villabona, municipalities with historical-artistic, archaeological and above all naturalistic values. We will also pass by Tolosa, an important town of the area being its historic center one of the largest with abundance of public buildings dating from the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries.

Little by little, we will introduce ourselves to the interior of Guipuzkoa and we will arrive at Ordizia. This typical villa in the area of Goierri has an old historic district declared as Monumental-Historic Set. Continuation of the trip to the Rioja Alavesa until Laguardia, famous town for its historical monumental set and mainly for its cellars. Free time to tour the village and have lunch in one of its typical restaurants.

After lunch we will go to Vitoria where we will start a Panoramic Tour. Free time to visit the center and the Old Town of Vitoria. Accommodation at the Hotel in Vitoria.

D9 Friday VITORIA – BILBAO: Vell Añana, Balmaseda, Getxo

Breakfast. On the way we will pass through rural areas and natural landscapes. We arrived at Gesaltza (Añana saltworks). We will enter Land of Ayala, one of the few places where nature is so generous. We will continue the journey following the edge of the sea towards Portugalete, famous for its Suspension Bridge, dating from 1893 and is the oldest suspension bridge of transport in the world.

Once on the other side of the shore, we will be in Getxo. Later we will arrive to Bilbao, we will begin a Panoramic Tour. 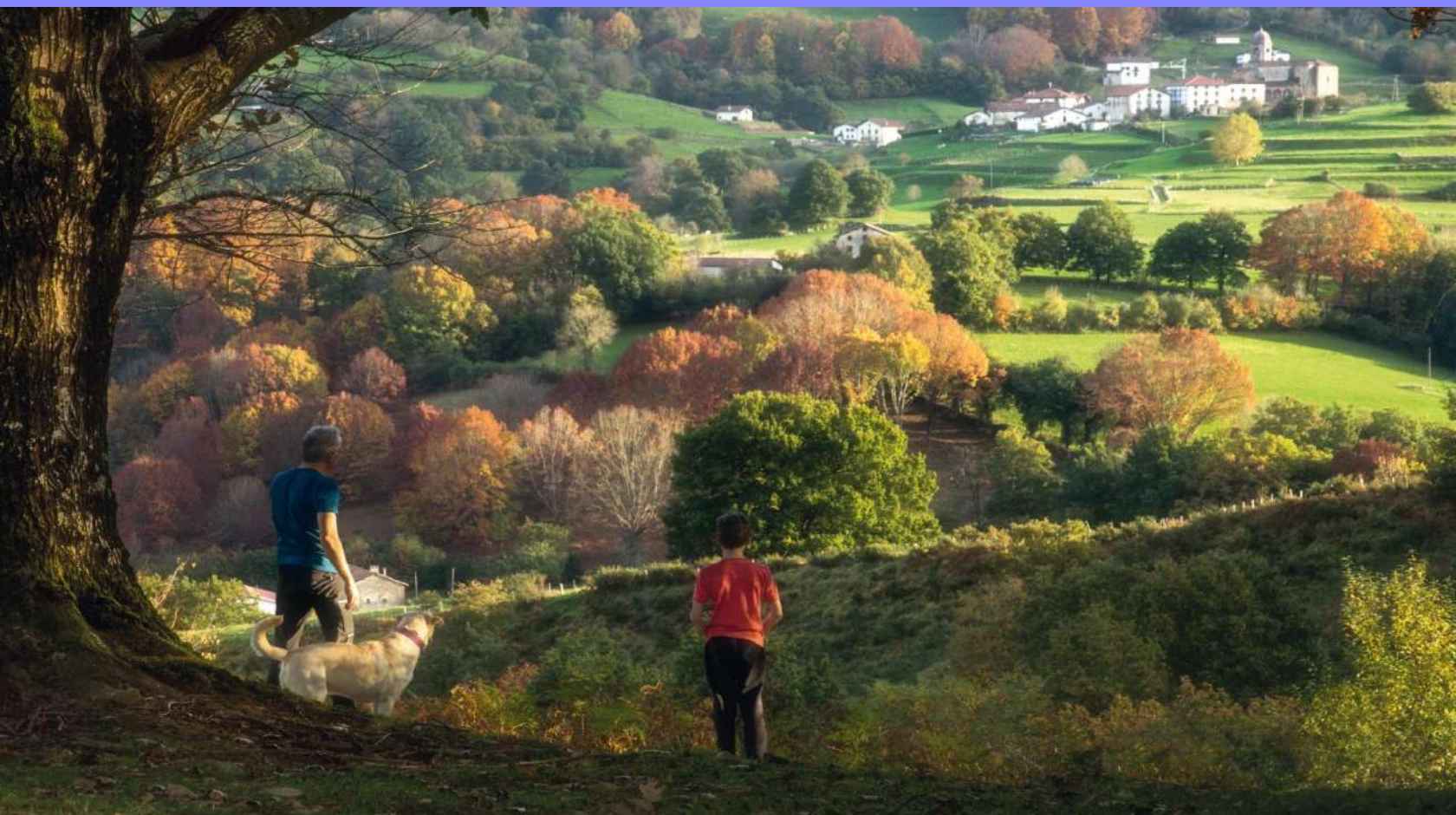
